

**WEST MANHEIM TOWNSHIP RECREATION PARK
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1) **PARK HOURS: PARK OPEN DAWN TO DUSK**
- 2) No camping and/or sleeping on Park property or in any vehicles on Park property.
- 3) No one shall injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any trees, plants, shrubs, turf, buildings, structures, signs or fixtures, or any other property located within the Park
- 4) Trash must be picked up and placed in proper trash receptacles.
- 5) No fires allowed except in grills. Ashes should be disposed of in designated hot ash receptacles.
- 6) No one shall remove any bench, seat, table or other property from the Park.
- 7) Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times, and are allowed in specific areas as designated by the Board of Supervisors. **YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.**
- 8) No notices or placards shall be posted in the Park without permission of the Board of Supervisors.
- 9) Sale of any articles or service is prohibited, as well as any type of solicitation, without permission of the Board of Supervisors.
- 10) Vehicles or any type of conveyance are not allowed to be operated, stopped, or parked except within areas designated by the Board of Supervisors. Authorized vehicles shall not be operated in a reckless or negligent manner as to become a nuisance to other area users.
- 11) Motorized off-road vehicles to include, but not limited to, ATV's, scooters, snowmobiles, dirt bikes, etc. are prohibited on Park property.
- 12) No parking on grass except when authorized by the Board of Supervisors.
- 13) No alcohol or illegal drugs are permitted in the Park.
- 14) No one shall be in the Park in an intoxicated state or otherwise be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time.
- 15) No one shall carry or discharged on Park property any, slingshots, firecrackers, fireworks or other missile-propelling instruments, explosives, arrows or other dangerous weapons, which could cause annoyance or injury to any person.
- 16) No firearm, of any type, may be discharged on Park property.
- 17) No trapping or hunting of any animals is permitted in the Park.
- 18) Pitching horseshoes shall be allowed only in designated areas.
- 19) No disrobing or changing of clothing.

- 20) No disturbing the peace by any conduct. No use of threatening, abusive, insulting, profane, or obscene language or words. No committing disorderly or immoral acts.
- 21) Music should be kept to a level so that it is not disturbing others that are using the Park.
- 22) Public meetings or rallies of more than five persons are not allowed without permission of the Board of Supervisors.
- 23) Speed limit is 15 m.p.h.
- 24) The cleaning, polishing, greasing, changing oil or making repairs to any vehicle is prohibited.

RESERVATION OF PAVILIONS AND BALL FIELDS: Pavilions and Ball fields may be reserved through the West Manheim Township Recreation and Parks Board. Reservations are good for the entire day during Park hour.

- Large Pavilion 1 available (15 tables, holds approximately 90 people)
- Medium Pavilions 3 available (6 tables, hold approximately 36 people)
- Small Pavilions 2 available (2 tables, holds approximately 12 people)
- Multipurpose Ball Fields
(Soccer/Baseball/Football/etc.)
- Volleyball Courts (2 available)
- Horseshoe Pitts: (Bring your own shoes)

General usage of all Park facilities are free, however, reservations take precedence.

Cancellations will be refunded up to 5 days prior to reservation date. Cancellations of 5 days or less prior to reservation date are non-refundable.

If it is necessary to clean up or move tables back into their proper place after a rental, a \$50.00 per hour surcharge will be imposed and billed to the renter.
