Payment of connection fee by the property owner(s) authorizes same to facilitate an approved pressure sewer lateral connection to West Manheim Sanitary Sewer System.

Prior to any installation work beginning, the following items must be submitted for review and approval by West Manheim Township.

1. A site plan showing location of the grinder pump unit, routing of all piping, (both gravity and pressure), and all electrical wiring.
2. Type of grinder pump, manufacturer, model number, horsepower, voltage, size of grinder pump unit discharge pipe and where the pump is to be obtained.
3. Elevation difference between the grinder pump and the discharge point to the municipal sewer system.
4. The length and size of the pressure sewer from the grinder pump unit to the municipal sewer system.
5. Catalog cut showing recommended application, pump, specifications, and motor specifications. Pump performance curve showing capacity at various heads and a catalog cut of the control panel and alarm systems.
6. Minimum capacity of the grinder pump wet well is 300 gallons. The submittal shall also specify the actual capacity and material of the pump tank. Include anti-flotation steps that are going to be taken (ie. Concrete hold down pad, compacted backfill ect.)
7. All plans submitted for review must be by a registered professional engineer. A grinder pump must be specified unless an exception is approved by the Township Engineer and the Township Plumbing Inspector.

The contractor installing the pressure sewer lateral must provide Township representative with a 48 hour advance notice, (weekends and holidays excluded), to schedule an inspection of the in place grinder pump unit, pressure sewer lateral and gravity sewer lateral.

All connections to the sanitary sewer system must be inspected and approved by a duly authorized representative of West Manheim Township prior to backfill operations.

Prior to the final inspection an interior inspection is required.

The contractor has a maximum of 30 days from the time the installation starts to abandon the on-lot tank.
